❖ Temple Tours: Small Circuit



Brief Details:

Spend the whole day exploring the awesome temples of Angkor, including Angkor Wat, the world's largest sacred building and an architectural masterpiece. Enter the southern Gate of Angkor Thom, to visit Prasat Bayon, temple of the enigmatic stone face towers, before visiting the 350 meter long 'Terrace of the Elephants' and the mysterious 'Terrace of the Leper King.' After lunch and a short rest at the hotel during the heat of the day. In the afternoon visit the jungle temple Ta-Prohm one of the most atmospheric of all temples in Angkor complex and reknowned movie set "Tomb Raider"

❖ Temple Tours: Big Circuit



Brief Details:

The Grand Tour is actually an extension of the Small Circuit and runs through Preah Khan, Preah Neak Pean to the Eastern Mebon and other temple monuments of Ta Som & Pre Rup. The Grand Circuit complex showcases the rich and sophisticated architecture of Khmer Empire, the best things about the Grand tour circuit temples are that it is slightly off the beaten track and thus quieter. The scenery breath taking and every corner of the temples are a photographer's dream!

Preah Khan built in the 12th century was one of Jayavarman VII's largest projects dedicated to his farther. The temple was built as much more than a temple as it was the education center for over 1000 teachers, it appears also to have been a buddhist university as well as a considerable city.

Neak Poan was built to represent a paradisiacal Himalayan Mountain Lake. East Mebon was guarded as its corners by stone figures of hardnessed elephants, some of which are still in a reasonable state of preservation. Heading to Prasat

East Mebon Is a majestic 10th Century temple, the tour then continues to **Prasat Prerub**, a Hindu temple at Angkor, built as the state temple of khmer king Rajendravarmen and completed in 961. This temple is constructed of combined brick, laterite and sandstone. **Ta Som** built at end of the 12th century for King Jayavarman VII. It is located north east of Angkor Thom.

❖ Temple Tours: Banteay Srey + Beng Mealea



Brief details:

A two-hour drive from Siem Reap, stands Boeng Mealea almost forgotten in the jungle, crumbling and covered in sprawling tree roots. It is the largest temple outside the main Angkor complex and is enclosed by an enormous moat. We spend the morning at Boeng Mealea, then journey the 1.5 hours to the intricately carved and well-preserved Ban- teay Srei and have a restaurant lunch on arrival (lunch and drinks at your expense). The detailed reliefs on this smaller sandstone structure are regarded as the finest, most skillfully crafted in Cambodia. Return to your hotel late afternoon.

❖ Tours: Kulen Mountain + Beng Mealea



Brief details:

A two-hour drive from Siem Reap to one of the most popular attractions in Cambodia is the majestic **Phnom Kulen Mountain**, located about 1.5-2 hours away, located about 50 kilometers from the city of Siem Reap. The mountain was given its name due to the abundance of lychee trees it once hosted, for those who plan to drive up to the top of Kulen Mountain, you need to get there early, as the road is one-way traffic only.

Phnom Kulen is one of Cambodia's most revered sites. According to legend, it was here that King Jayavarman II declared independence from Java in 802 CE and thus began the Khmer Empire – as an independent nation. Additionally, it's a very sacred site with multiple temples easily accessible. Two sites most noted are the **Thousand Lingas** at **Kbal Spean**, within the Kulen National Park site and **Preah Ang Thom pagoda** with its giant reclining Buddha.

And continue your day to **Boeng Mealea** almost forgotten in the jungle, crumbling and covered in sprawling tree roots. It is the largest temple outside the main Angkor complex and is enclosed by an enormous moat.

Highlights:

- Visit one of the most interesting temples outside the main Angkor group.
- Kulen mountain offers visitors a beautiful view, as well as fun activities such as picnicking and waterfall swimming.
- Enjoy a traditional Khmer lunch at a local restaurant near the temple or on the mountain (lunch does not included)

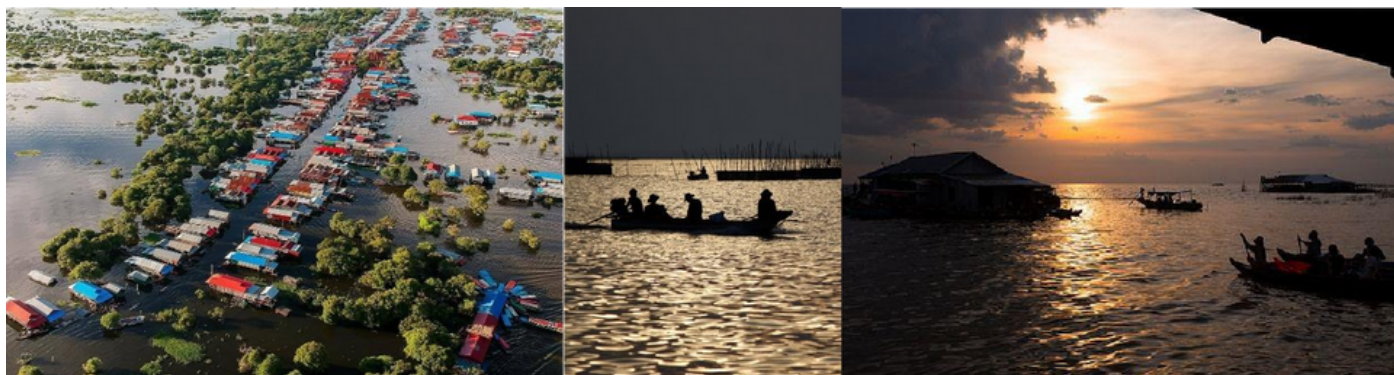

❖ Floating Village Tour: Kampong Phluk



Brief details:

Drive approximately 45 minutes to the traditional and remote fishing village of Kompong Pluk or Mechrey. Board a traditional wooden fishing boat and learn about the remarkable lifestyles led by Khmer fishing communities living on the lake and see an entirely different side of Cambodia.

See floating villages, fishing nets being mended, children swimming and playing, and even floating pigpens! Continue out on the massive lake, past local fishermen and an amazing array of boats before returning to Siem Reap Township by noon.

- See daily activities of locals living permanently on the water, away from large crowds of tourists

❖ Temples Tours: Roluos Group



Brief details:

Roluos Group is a small group of few interesting temples outside from the main Angkor complex, Roluos archeological site about 13 km east of Siem Reap along national road 06, Among the "**Roluos Group**" of temples there are some of the earliest permanent structures built by Khmer. They mark the beginning of classical period of Khmer civilization, dating from the late 9th century. Some were totally built with bricks, others partially with laterite or sandstone (the first large Angkorian temple built with sandstone was possibly Ta Keo)

At present it is composed by three major temples: **Bakong**, **Lolei**, and **Preah Ko**, along with the smaller **Prasat Prei Monti**. At both **Bakong** and **Lolei** there are contemporary Theravada buddhist monasteries.

Bakong is the first Khmer temple mountain of sandstone constructed by rulers of the Khmer Empire at Angkor near modern Siem Reap in Cambodia. In the final decades of the 9th century AD, it served as the official state temple of King Indravarman I in the ancient city of Hariharalaya,

Lolei is the northernmost temple of the Roluos group of three late 9th century Hindu temples at Angkor, Cambodia, is thought to be a modern corruption of the ancient name "Hariharalaya," which means "the city of Harihara." Once an island temple,

Preah Ko (Sacred Bull) derives its name from the three statues of sandstone located in the front of and facing the temple's central towers. These statues represent Nandi, the white bull who serves as the mount of Shiva.

❖ Waterfalls Tour: Kbal Spean



Brief details:

A 40 minutes' drive from Siem Reap to one of the best historical backgrounds of Cambodia, Kbal Spean is the carving of vestiges begun with the reign of King Suryavarman I and ended with the reign of King Jayadityavarman II, these two kings ruled between the 11th and 12th centuries. The 1,000 lingas, but not other sculptures, are attributed to a minister of Suryavarman I during the 11th century, and these were carved by hermits who lived in the area. Inscriptions at the site testify to the fact that most of the sculpting was done during the reign of Udayadityavarman II. It is also mentioned that King Udayadityavarman II consecrated a golden linga here in 1059 AD. It is believed that the Siem Reap River flowing into Angkor is blessed by the sacred lingas over which it flows.

❖ Temple Tour: Koh Ker



Brief details:

Koh Ker is a remote archaeological site in northern Cambodia about 120 kilometers and is about two and half hours' drive away from Siem Reap and the ancient site of Angkor, and the ancient site of Angkor, It is a jungle filled region that is sparsely populated, More than 180 sanctuaries were found in a protected area of 81 square kilometers.

Koh Ker is the modern name for an important city of the Khmer empire. And Under the reign of the kings Jayavarman IV and Harshavarman II Koh Ker was briefly the capital of the whole empire (928–944 AD).

Jayavarman IV enforced an ambitious building program. An enormous water-tank and about forty temples were constructed under his rule. The most significant temple-complex, a double sanctuary (Prasat Thom/Prang), follows a linear plan and not a concentric one like most of the temples of the Khmer kings. Unparalleled is the 36-metre (118 ft)-high seven-tiered pyramid, which most probably served as state temple of Jayavarman IV. Really impressive too are the shrines with the two-meter 6 ft 7 in high lingas.
